Grading Policy

Grading Categories:

The following categories are weighted as shown.

Homework/Classwork	15%
Quiz	25%
Labs	25%
Tests	35%

Late Work Policy:

If a student does not hand in an assignment on the scheduled due date, he/she immediately receives a zero (0) in my grade book. If the student shows the initiative to get that assignment turned in at another time (within reason), I will change the zero to a full credit grade. Of course, if he/she hands in the assignment 6 weeks late (!), full credit is not deserved, but some will still be given. A situation like this will be determined on a case-by-case basis. Since high school is less than a year away, I will NOT remind students to hand in late assignments. The responsibility is their own!

Re-Take Policy:

Any student receiving *below* a 70% on a quiz or test will be allowed a chance to take another similar quiz or test. The 1st and 2nd scores will be averaged together and capped at a 70% for a final grade. This gives students an opportunity to correct for a very bad day and still remains fair to those who achieved higher than a 70 the first time around. This is meant as a safety net and NOT a regular testing policy. Again, I will NOT chase students for re-takes. The responsibility is their own to come and set up a time with me!

Labs are not included in my re-take policy as these are performed in class for multiple days and I expect students to ask any necessary questions *before* they hand in their work.
